Mini Camp: (MINI) **Ages 6-8** **July 1-3rd**
 This camp is especially designed for our first time campers and is offered concurrently with Russian River Adventures I, allowing campers to attend with older siblings. Campers will experience highlights of our unique camping program.

Russian River Adventures II: (RRII) **Ages 8-12** **July 5-July 10th**

Hang Out & Work N' Stuff (HOW) **Ages 13-15** **July 11-17th**
 Campers will experience a week serving the camp community by leading and participating in service projects. Campers will also participate in traditional camp activities. *15-year olds are strongly encouraged to participate in the Counselor-In-Training (CIT) program during this session and may apply to serve as a CIT during the last Russian River Adventures Program for \$250.*
